COUNCILLOR VACANCY

PARKING REGULATIONS

We have received a response from South Essex Parking Partnership (SEPP) regarding our application to change the parking regulations along Basin Road (Daisy Meadow Car Park to The Jolly Sailor). The aim of the application was to ensure clear access for emergency vehicles and to prevent resident's driveways from being obstructed by visitor parking during busy periods. SEPP has unfortunately rejected our application providing several reasons and concluding that there is not a major parking issue. This decision was made without any prior discussion with the Parish Council.

In response, we have written to SEPP highlighting the flaws in their assessment and have formally requested a face-to-face meeting to discuss the matter further. This remains an important issue, and we are committed to finding a solution.
